Luke 18: 1-8

In prayer, should we always be resigned to god's will: should our words always be 'nice'? Not according to this parable! And not according to many of the Psalms, which cry out to God with anger, elation, anguish and heartache. Jesus is clear that we should bring our real selves to God – our real emotions, our real desires. Maybe God can see our situation more clearly, maybe other people are impacted in different ways, and maybe God knows there are deeper desires beyond the surface ones. Yet God can also see our faith and seeks the wellbeing of all. As Martin Luther King Junior reminds us, "The arc of the moral universe is long, but it bends toward justice?". Change happens, though it is ever so slow. Our role is to "pray continually and never lose heart". We need not be satisfied with the world as it is, but seek justice especially for the powerless. Rather than calm detachment, faith is trust in God's goodness despite the circumstances. Let us be real in our prayer and persistent in our actions for what is right.

"Shane has many strengths but, for us, a very important one is the care and respect and interest he shows to everyone he is involved with," the couple said.

"He has a great gift of being able to relate to people of all ages and levels.

"People are important to Shane and he always has a sincere interest in them and their lives."

Mr and Mrs Mackinlay said a highlight from the installation Mass was seeing the large number of priests and bishops who were there to celebrate with him.

"And it was especially significant for us that a big number of the priests from his Sandhurst Diocese had come to Brisbane for the installation which, we think, reflects how highly he has been regarded by them as their bishop and the strength of the friendship he has with them," they said.

"Also significant were the many friends and priests from other parts of Victoria and interstate who are important to Shane and who are important to him.

"It was good to see them there and that they had come to celebrate with

him and add their support for this next part of his priesthood."

Mr and Mrs Mackinlay said they have been "very proud of all that Shane has done and achieved in his life as a priest".

"He seems to have a great capacity to make time to do all sorts of things, from spending time with a community of elderly religious sisters, through to planning the new complex to be built for the diocesan offices in Bendigo.
